"Dragon boat activities" means performing or participating in the dragon boating in any capacity which includes, but is not limited to, participation in training, competitions, coaching or as an official.

I acknowledge that I am exposed to certain risks during dragon boat activities and that accidents can happen which may result in me being injured or even killed, or my property being damaged. I have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in dragon boat activities.

Release and Indemnity:

In consideration of DBWA accepting my application for membership I, to the extent permitted by law:

(a) release and will release DBWA from all Claims that I may have or may have had but for this release arising from or in connection with my membership and/or participation in dragon boat activities and

(b) indemnify and will keep indemnified DBWA in respect of any Claim by any person arising as a result of or in connection with my membership and/or participation in dragon boat activities.

Fitness to Participate: I declare that I am medically and physically fit and able to participate in the dragon boat activities. I will immediately notify DBWA in writing of any change to my medical condition, fitness or ability to participate. I understand and accept that DBWA will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

Medical Treatment: I consent to receiving any medical treatment that the DBWA reasonably considers necessary or desirable for me during my participation in dragon boat activities. I also agree to reimburse DBWA for any costs or expenses incurred in providing me with medical treatment.

Right to Use Image: I acknowledge and consent to photographs and electronic images being taken of me during my participation in dragon boat activities to be used in any form of media, to promote dragon boating.

DRAGON BOATING WA CODE OF CONDUCT

Whilst performing their duties as members of a crew associated as a member or affiliate of Dragon Boating WA Inc, members will, as well as adhering to the Constitution of Dragon Boating WA Inc:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants and officials regardless of their ability, gender or cultural background. Abusive or violent conduct of any nature towards any paddler, club, race official or spectator will not be tolerated.
2. Abide by the Dragon Boating WA Member Protection Policy.
3. Act respectfully towards race officials, other crews and spectators at all times.
4. Avoid individual or collective behaviour that is likely to incite spectators to act in a disorderly or violent manner.
5. Make no detrimental statements in public in respect of the performance of any race officials.
6. Make no statements in public regarding the actions or decisions of DBWA.
7. Behave in a sportsperson like manner both on the water and off the water and will not do anything that may cause embarrassment or adverse publicity for DBWA or the sport of dragon boating.
8. Not use, attempt to use, have in his or her possession, attempt to have in his or her possession , traffic or attempt to traffic any illegal drug or substance.
